

Venetian Blind Care Guide

- Always raise the blinds if windows and doors are open. A strong breeze could catch and damage the blind.
- Avoid exposure to wind or rain. Rain blown onto the blind might stain the slats and these spots can be difficult to remove.
- To raise the blinds, stand directly in front of the cords.

CLEANING VENETIAN BLINDS

Vaccum the slats with a brush attachment, or dust with a soft brush, weekly to prevent a build up of dirt. Over time, this build up can be very difficult to remove without damaging the slats.

Spot clean any marks with a soft damp cloth, making sure the cloth is not too wet to guard against water marks.

If using a cleaning product, always test in an inconspicuous spot first.



Venetian Blind

- Raise the blind when the doors and windows are open to prevent damage
- Vaccum or dust slats weekly to prevent dirt building up
- Exposure to rain can cause staining
- Spot clean with a damp, soft cloth
- Do not spray window cleaner on or near the blinds
