

Mesh & PVC Fabric Care Guide

Sunscreen Mesh fabric.

* Clean the awning with a soft cloth and soapy cold water. Use a heavily diluted detergent such as dishwashing soap.

* Never apply full strength detergents, cleaning fluids, soaps, insecticides or garden sprays.

Do not use bore water or allow bore water sprinkler systems to wet the awning. Never allow petrochemicals or solvents to touch the awning.

* Do not use a high-pressure hose to clean the awning.

PVC Blinds.

- Do not use window cleaning detergents to clean the PVC.

- Clean the blind with a soft cloth and soapy water.

- Never allow bird droppings, dirt or stains to remain on the PVC for long periods of time.

- The PVC surface is highly sensitive to scratching and marks. Always be cautious when cleaning, operating or moving items around PVC awnings.

- Ideally, use a soft, clean cloth to polish and dry the PVC after cleaning and prior to rolling up the awning.

- Do not use a high-pressure hose to clean the awning.



Mesh & PVC Fabric

- Clean with a soft cloth and cold soapy water
- Do not use a high pressure hose
- Clean off bird droppings, dirt and stains as soon as possible
- PVC is prone to scratching, so take care when cleaning or moving objects near the awning
